MINIES.

Child Heart Purses

Materials Needed:

Size 4 US Knitting Needles (plus one extra for casting off)

- 2 Skeins of Minnie Black(A)
- 1 Skein of Minnie Yellow(B)
- 1 Skein of Minnie Lime Green(C)
- 1 Skein of Minnie Pink(D)

Markers

Stitches used: Moss Stitch

K1, P1 for right side P1, K1 for wrong side

This pattern is worked with 2 strands of Black to form the handle and top of purse, it is done in a Moss Stitch.

With color A cast on 84 stitches placing marker after stitch #42.

- 1-4 work these 4 rows in Moss Stitch.
- 5. K1, P1 for the first 14 stitches, then cast off 14 stitches, then work the next 28 stitches in the Moss stitch pattern, then cast off another 14 stitches, continue to work the Moss stitch to the end of the row. (the cast of stitches will make the handles for the purse)
- 6. P1, K1 for 14 stitches, then cast on 14 stitches, then work 28 stitches in Moss stitch, then cast on 14 stitches, and continue to work Moss stitch to the end of the row.
- 7-14 Work Moss stitch.
- 15. Change to color B and K21, change to color C and K21, change to color D and K21, change to color E and K21.

- 16. And every even # row you will Purl all stitches when working graph.
- 17-60 Start chart working from Right to Left and Purling all even (wrong side) rows. Be sure to change colors every 21 stitches to keep your color pattern. Also make sure when you change colors you twist the previous color and the new color in back of your work so that you will not end up with holes where you change colors.
- 61. Do a 3 needle cast off, sew up side of purse seam, sew in ends and block purse. Use a piece of black fabric to fit for the lining and sew in place.
