

MATERIALS NEEDED

- 1 Skein Noodles White
- Size 12 knitting needles
- Fabric Dye or Kool-Aid(unsweetened)– Pink, Yellow, Orange, Green and Blue
- Plastic Ice Cube Tray
- Measuring spoon (Tablespoon)
- Plastic Wrap
- Glass or Ceramic baking pan

DIRECTIONS

Cast on 14 stitches.

Rows 1& 2: knit all stitches.

Row 3: Knit wrapping yarn twice.

Row 4: Knit dropping extra loops.

Repeat rows 1-4. End scarf after row 2, cast off stitches, sew in ends.

Mix 6 drops of each color of fabric dye or unsweetened Kool-Aid with 6 tablespoons of water (this will make 3 ice cubes of each color). Once cubes are frozen wet scarf and squeeze out excess water.

Place scarf in baking dish and place ice cubes around and on top of scarf, cover with plastic wrap and place in the sun. You can repeat the process several times to get more color. Once you have finished dyeing the scarf place in a sink of cold water with 1 cup of vinegar to set the colors. Hand wash scarf and lay flat to dry.
