

MINNIES *Granny Square Headband*

Materials Needed:

Size 00 crochet hook
1 Skein Minnie Yellow
1 Skein Minnie Orange
1 Skein Minnie Fushia
1 Skein Minnie Green
1 Skein Minnie Blue

To get started, chain 4 (ch 4), and join to form a ring.

Once you make the ring, chain 3 (ch 3)—this will count as your first dc. Make 2 more dcs in ring. This is your first 3 dc shell.

Ch 2, and make 3 dc in ring. Repeat from 2 more times, ch 2 and join yarn to the 3rd ch of the round. You'll have a nice little starter square.

Join the yarn in one of the ch-2 spaces (these are all corners, at this point). I like to join mine before the yarn end I just left so that I can crochet over the ends as I go, but there's no "right" corner to join to—after all, you have a symmetrical shape, no matter which way you rotate it. Ch 3 to count as your first dc.



In the same ch-2 space: 2 dc, ch 2, 3 dc. You've just made a corner.

*In the next corner, (3 dc, ch 2, 3 dc). Ch 1, skip the previous round's shell. Repeat from * twice and join to the third stitch of the round.

For an adult headband make 12 squares for youth make 10 for child make 8.



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
